Church Reopening Update

One of the biggest holiday celebrations in the Christian experience is upon us and I pray everyone in the House of God Church will observe, reflect and celebrate the true meaning of the season - the immaculate birth of our savior, Jesus Christ. With many people traveling for family gatherings, attending holiday activities and meeting in groups, it is important to continue exercising caution, adhering to the recommended Center for Disease Control guidelines and church protocols.

I am encouraged by the progress being made with the vaccination of children 5 to 11 years of age and the increase in vaccination rates across the country. If you or your children are not vaccinated, consult your primary care physician to determine the best vaccination options for you and your family.

After prayerful consideration, the Supreme Executive Council and I have reached an agreement (unanimously) that will allow House of God facilities to be open a maximum of 2 days per week until further notice. The total recommended time is a maximum of 3.5 hours per day. If you choose, the 2 days can be used for worship service, holiday activities, Watch Night service, rehearsal, meetings or a "seven days fast" lesson. Our objective is to keep everyone safe, spiritually engaged and doing God's will. I pray this added optional opportunity will bless your church and community.
